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DEAR FRIENDS!

The year 2019 has passed, the year when our organization worked to make the life of the children better and brighter. Like any other previous periods, this year has been the time of painstaking and efficient work. By the opinions polls Charity Public Association "World Without Borders" entered the top of 10 most recognizable public organizations in the Republic of Belarus in all 4 nominations: among specialists, among youth, business communities and representatives of governmental authorities.

Anticipating the present annual report, I want to note that this year has been filled with difficult challenges and vivid events, important changes and effective work. "World Without Borders" continued its course aimed at helping the children with disabilities, living in the house-boarding institutions, as well as adolescents in conflict with the law, including those located in the closed-type institutions. Our projects were aimed at helping children and young people and training the staff of these institutions, professionals and stakeholders.

For the first time, "World Without Borders" came close to the problem of complex deinstitutionalization of the children with disabilities living in the house-boarding institutions. And on the basis of Ivenets house-boarding institution in the framework of the project "Chance for Everyone" recommendations on the deinstitutionalization were developed and the roadmap for their implementation was composed. And we are sincerely glad that, as always, active help and support with understanding of our values we found from Ministry of Labor and Social Protection, from Ministry of Education, from the representatives of Labor and Social Protection Regional Committees as well as from Education Minsk Regional Executive Committee, from local



authorities, representatives of Socio-Pedagogical Centers and Day Care Centers. Important for the planning of the process of deinstitutionalization were the events organized with the parents of children living in the house-boarding institutions, as well as those who have disabled children at home.

Since 2004, World Without Borders has been working with teenagers in conflict with the Law: how to help such a teenager, what to do in order to make he or she who belongs to dysfunctional categories, move to another team and fully realize their aspirations without harm to surrounding and social norms; what do their parents need - all these issues are on the agenda of discussions, trainings and analysis in the framework of our projects. With the implementation of the form of work "Contact Persons" understanding of new challenges and new decisions has come. Can a Contact Friend help? How will he do it? How to improve efficiency preventive work and what new forms to use? Is there such a technique in the world? Using international experience we could increase the knowledge and competencies of specialists and professionals. Completely new form of work by WWB was tested in 2019. It is on-line training.

Over 200 professionals improved their knowledge without leaving home.

Very significant in preventive work with teenagers were organizing and conducting KVN "Autumn Marathon" creative action, which traditionally attracts significant number of participants and viewers and helps to reform the children on socially oriented behavior patterns.

What is the role of WWB in protecting children's rights? This topic demanded especially a lot of time and efforts in 2019. Starting from training the staff, including volunteers and members of the Board of the organization, we have developed our own Child Protection Policy. Enforcing the rights of children with whom we are working as well as the commitment of our partners to these values are issued in this document.

The project "To Know in Order to Help", which WWB is implementing, helps us, together with the representatives of state bodies and other public organizations, to understand the issues of the rights of children with disabilities, what they include and what needs to be done in order for this or that right to be realized.

Children's sports competitions and summer events will remain unforgettable in the children's memory, which allowed them to be in a fairy tale for several days, directed by the staff and volunteers of WWB. The annual festival "Dreams Come True" brought together representatives of children from all 9 house-boarding institutions. The winner was Rechitsa house-boarding institutions, which will go to represent talents to the Kingdom of Sweden in 2020. WWB does not remain aloof from the action "Our Children"! 170 children from all the institutions with which WWB cooperates were able to participate in the event, which was organized on the eve of the New Year 2020.

The project «TEEN in the centre»

Since the beginning of the year, the project experience has been systematized and distance learning materials have been created. One of the project specialists completed a series of trainings to create an online training course. After completing the training, an online course was developed with the possibility of training for an unlimited number of people without time reference instead of webinars (online seminars), which were originally in the work plans.



The development of materials was carried out jointly with specialists from Social-Pedagogical Centers from Baranovichy town and Soligorsk town. Two meetings were held of the working groups (40 people) and 3 training seminars for specialists (70 people), where participants brainstormed on the topics of the course and reported on topics on which they would like to be trained. These ideas were transformed into an action plan.

The training course was started in September on a free platform for online learning and was available for an unlimited number of people and the platform used (Moodle) allowed to track the number of participants taking the course.

200 people registered for the course. Each participant who successfully completed the training received a state certificate. Unexpectedly, a great interest in training was shown by specialists from Russia, Ukraine and Kazakhstan, every fourth participant in the course was a foreign specialist.



The model of work «Contact person»

This direction of the project is focused on providing social assistance to pupils and graduates of special educational institutions, who came into conflict with the law, on the selection and functioning of contact persons for specific adolescents in order to facilitate their rehabilitation and resocialization.

The main objectives of this project are:

1. To prepare a group of contact persons and volunteers working at a professional level, allowing children who are in special institutions of the closed type, as well as graduates to maximize their rights and opportunities.
2. To ensure the interaction of pupils from the closed type institutions and contact persons.

The “Contact Person” work model is a system of work with children in conflict with the law, which implies escort of the ward, based on the principles of trust. Contact person also performs the connecting role of the guardianship of the person and representatives of state bodies and institutions providing qualified help.



To date, the organization has 55 contact persons (10 of which are new) who provide help of various kinds to 104 pupils and 65 graduates of these institutions.

Throughout the whole time, careful selection of candidates for the role of contact person is constantly conducted, through interviews, testing, questionnaires and also conducted training seminars and working meetings. For contact persons, 1 training three-day seminar was held in which more than 20 people took part. Once every 2 months the meetings of the working groups for contact persons are organized. 10 new people have become contact friends for 15 pupils.

Over the past period, with the participation of contact persons and volunteers, 18 events were organized to prevent nicotine, alcohol and drug addiction and promotion of a healthy lifestyle on the basis of educational institutions and medical educational institutions of the closed type. All these events were carried out by volunteers and contact friends. Famous Belarusian pop artists were involved in these events. For example, the leading singer of the LSP group is Petr Klyuyev, uncle Vanya (Ivan Vabishchevich), Bakey (Vladislav Belmach), Anastasia Tihanovich and others. Thanks to the participation of the famous artists, teenagers have become visible among the general public. Some artists have become contact friends for the children. Thanks to outdoor activities, trusting relationships between adolescents and contact friends have become more intimate and frank.

Contact persons usually establish communication between the children of the closed type institutions and their legal representatives. By the request of the children contact friends get in touch with the parents and relatives of the children, with which for various reasons they didn't have any contact trying to change the situation.

Thus, thanks to the work of the contact persons over the past year, assistance was provided to twelve pupils in establishing communication with their parents; seven graduates received help in choosing a profession and places to get it; employment was found for 3 graduates; 50% of pupils and graduates received legal, psychological and other types of help. Contact persons continue to provide escort for minors after leaving the closed type institutions, including children without parental care.

Contact persons take an active part in the life of the graduates, helping with their labour activities, adaptation into a new social environment, including in the labour team, forming a positive motivation to achieve goals.



Specialists of both special closed type institutions and schools where the children come after leaving the closed type institutions actively use the help of contact persons in obtaining additional information about a teenager, communication with his parents. The help includes assistance in preparing homework, accompaniment to schools and control of the place of staying, control over the sober lifestyle, accompaniment at the premises of medical institutions (expert in narcology, psychiatrist, etc.), hobby classes during free time. Escorting the graduates while visiting specialists is especially relevant and in demand of the schools. After all, the presence of a contact person helps a teenager to feel more comfortable and calm which helps to solve the issue rather quickly.

The project «Step forward»

In 2019, we approached the development of basic strategies for ensuring the right of every child with disability in our country to live and be raised in a family. For the first time in the Republic of Belarus an attempt was made on the creation of a roadmap for the deinstitutionalization of children with disabilities on the example of the state institution “Ivenets house-boarding institution for children young persons with disabilities” (hereinafter - Ivenets house-boarding institution).



To prepare the roadmap, the following was carried out: substantiation of the relevance of the deinstitutionalization of children with disabilities; analysis of the reasons for institutionalization of the residents of Ivenets house-boarding institution; analysis of the conditions and prerequisites for deinstitutionalization of children with disabilities in Minsk region; prevention of institutionalization of children with disabilities in Minsk region; living arrangements for the children of the house-boarding institution into a family; reorganization of Ivenets institution. Interdepartmental cooperation has been established, which is one of the main conditions for successful deinstitutionalization. 32 people from among managers, experts and specialists providing social services to families with disabled children and families raising children with disabilities joined the interdepartmental working groups and worked regularly throughout the year.

The reasons for institutionalization were found out due to socio-psychological research, using in-depth interviews and 4 focus groups in which 28 parents took part.



As a result, we received a list of the main reasons why parents left the children with disabilities to Ivenets house-boarding institution, a list of the main difficulties that parents face and an analysis of the family’s resources and its resilience. The request for social services for families raising children with disabilities in Volozhin district of Minsk region with the help of a survey among 90 families was conducted, which showed that the most important things for parents are to preserve, strengthen their child’s health, provide education and provide a barrier-free environment.

More than 40 specialists, representatives of national and regional government bodies, heads of institutions, specialists of national scientific and methodological and research institutions have studied international experience of deinstitutionalization of Russia, Moldova, Latvia, Ukraine and Georgia at 3 seminars. As a result, proposals were prepared



as a set of measures for the development of social services for families with children with disabilities and recommendations on prevention of institutionalization and deinstitutionalization were given. Reorganization plan of Ivenets house-boarding institution was prepared which suggests transferring of the house-boarding institution into the center of rehabilitation and habilitation of children and young people with

disabilities based on resource of base estimates, state of the personnel resources and the prospects for their development, sources of financing, opportunities to use them in the implementation of the process of deinstitutionalization. As a result of analytical, research, educational activities within the framework of the project, a draft of the Roadmap for deinstitutionalization of children of Ivenets house-boarding institution was prepared. The main achievement as we believe is the inclusion of our proposals for prevention of institutionalization, which are included in the Roadmap for the implementation of the complex of measures aimed at the step by step solution of problematic issues on socialization of persons with disabilities, approved by the Government of Belarus. For example, a proposal to develop a mechanism for interagency decision-making at the district level on issues of living arrangements of a child with disabilities, providing the placement of a child into a house-boarding institution only in exceptional cases.

The project «To know, in order to help»



The project aims to study and test international standards for monitoring and evaluating the implementation of the rights of children with disabilities rights as well as new approaches to expand opportunities for children with disabilities to use the rights guaranteed by the Convention on the Rights of the Child and Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities and is implemented in nine residential house-boarding institutions for children with disabilities.

In 2019 seminars were held for specialists of the General Prosecutor's Office, representatives of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection, the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Education, the Prosecutor's regional offices of Gomel, Vitebsk, Grodno, Minsk, the Scientific Research Institute of the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection, the Labor and Social Protection Committees of the Regional Executive Committees in order to determine the scope of monitoring rights and the main indicators of the realization of the rights.

In the framework of the project, a group of experts created a working version of an interdepartmental system for monitoring the implementation of children's rights in the house-boarding institutions for children with disabilities with special needs. Through monitoring it is supposed to monitor the situations in residential homes for disabled children with special needs in terms of implementation of children's rights and identifying problems in order to improve the quality of life of children with disabilities in residential institutions. To analyze the developed monitoring system as an effective tool for assessing the quality of life of children with disabilities in residential institutions, refinement of the content, identification of possible

problem areas and finalization of the development of this system, it is planned to conduct trial monitoring in the house-boarding institutions.

A group of the staff from different house-boarding institutions continues to develop teaching materials for training the rights to the children with disabilities, with the adaptation of using the materials even for children with severe multiple developmental disorders.





The internship was conducted for the employees of the house-boarding institutions to Sweden to familiarize them with the national laws and the process of realizing the rights of children with disabilities in local communities, educational institutions, families, with the availability and procedures for providing services and support for children with disabilities and their families as well

as to study the educational process for children with disabilities, new approaches in the field of inclusive education, the use of alternative communications.

An animated film and a board game on legal issues have been created for the introduction and training of the rights to the children with disabilities.



The internship was conducted for the employees of the house-boarding institutions to Sweden to familiarize them with the national laws and the process of realizing the rights of children with disabilities in Sweden.

Posters and stands on the rights of children using elements of alternative communication are published and delivered to the house-boarding institutions.

The above activities contribute to the increase of knowledge of the employees on issues of adequate implementation of national legislation in order to improve the quality of life of the residents of the house-boarding institutions, realisation of their legal rights and opportunities, contribute to the development of medical and social assistance to the children.

The action "Autumn Marathon"



From 3 to 5 December 2019, at the base of National Children's Educational and Health Center "Zubrenok" the republican creative KVN action "Autumn Marathon" was held. The organizer of the annual action was the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus. The staff of CPA "World Without Borders" took an active participation in the preparation and conduction of the event.

Regional teams of children "Orange Level" (Mogilev region), "Open and Press" (Mogilev), "23rd quarter", "LyceDZEisty" (Minsk region), "Cultural Capital" (Grodno region), "Manhattan", "Khrusteam" (Gomel region), "Day and Night" (Vitebsk region), "Team "R" (Minsk), "Devons" (Brest region), the "Doctor House" team included in the Major League of KVN were participating in the competition program. An important element of the action is the participation in it of the children who are staying in the closed type institutions, who committed crimes before the age of criminal responsibility, children who have had rich criminal experience in the past,

but are trying to return to a full, law-abiding life - the teams: "School's time" (Mogilev special closed type school), "Spetsy" (Mogilev closed type institution), "Again 25" (Krivichi closed type institution), "Object of attention" (Petrikov closed type institution).

Representatives of the Belarusian stage and show business took part as guests and members of the jury such as Vasily Antipov, Nikolai Drachinski, Anna Shalutina, as well as Alesya Meleschenya an inspector of the Department of Youth Affairs of the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Belarus, Inna Falevich, the representative of the Department of Internal Affairs of Minsk Regional Executive Committee.



The action contributed to the disclosure of the creative potential of children, the development of imaginative thinking, social interaction skills, their own personal values as well as the expansion of social contacts. This is not the first year KVN campaign has united the children who are called "difficult" trying to give them positive ways to solve their life problems. Through familiarizing to the movement with fun and resourceful guys, the children of our target group comprehend in practice alternatives to asocial forms of behaviour.



Thanks to the public demonstration of the gala concert on the last day of the rally, the professional community working with children in conflict with the law tried to show the need to prioritize the shift of punishment to help and support for these children. This year 5 teams more than in the previous one took part, which indicates the importance, relevance and need for such events.

An important element of the action is participation of the children from the closed type institutions in it.



The action "Our Children"

The New Year's charity holiday in the framework of the republican action "Our Children" for the residents of the house-boarding institutions, children of the closed-type educational institutions, those staying in Social-Pedagogical Centers was held at the base of Moulin Rouge Club. It was attended by 170 children.

Famous artists of Belarus gave the children wonderful time: such as Ivan Vabishchevich (Uncle Vanya), Anastasia Tihanovich, Oleg Khamenko, Sergey Dovganov, Bakey (Vladislav Belmach), Vanya Zdanyuk, drum DRUMKILLA show, aerialist Anastasia Kovalchuk, winners of the action "Autumn Marathon 2019" team under the title "Cultural Capital" (Grodno region), volunteers and others.



On behalf of the Ministry of Labor and Social protection the Republic of Belarus with New Year holidays the participants of the action were congratulated by the Deputy Head of the Department of Stationary Institutions of Social Services and Capital Construction Nikolai Orel.

The Festival “Dreams Come True”

The republican festival of creativity of children and young people with disabilities "Dreams Come True" is attended by children and young people with disabilities living in the house-boarding institutions. These guys are distinguished by the presence of serious diseases, some of which significantly limit the quality and duration of life. The festival over the years has become a kind of cultural bridge of understanding between disabled people and community. Today this is the only practical opportunity for the residents of the house-boarding institutions to realize their talents, realize creative ideas and show them to general public. For many children, this is a good opportunity to leave the walls of the institution at least for a while.

In 2019, the “Dreams Come True” festival was held in November at the Congress Hall of the Presidential Hotel and brought together about 100 participants, 600 spectators from Minsk schools, support groups from other house-boarding institutions and representatives of public organizations. The winner of the festival was a creative team from the house-boarding institution Rechitsa.



Alexander Soloduha, Uncle Vanya, Alexander Patlis, Alena Lanskaya – artists of stage and of the original genre of our country as well as professionals supported the children with their performances.

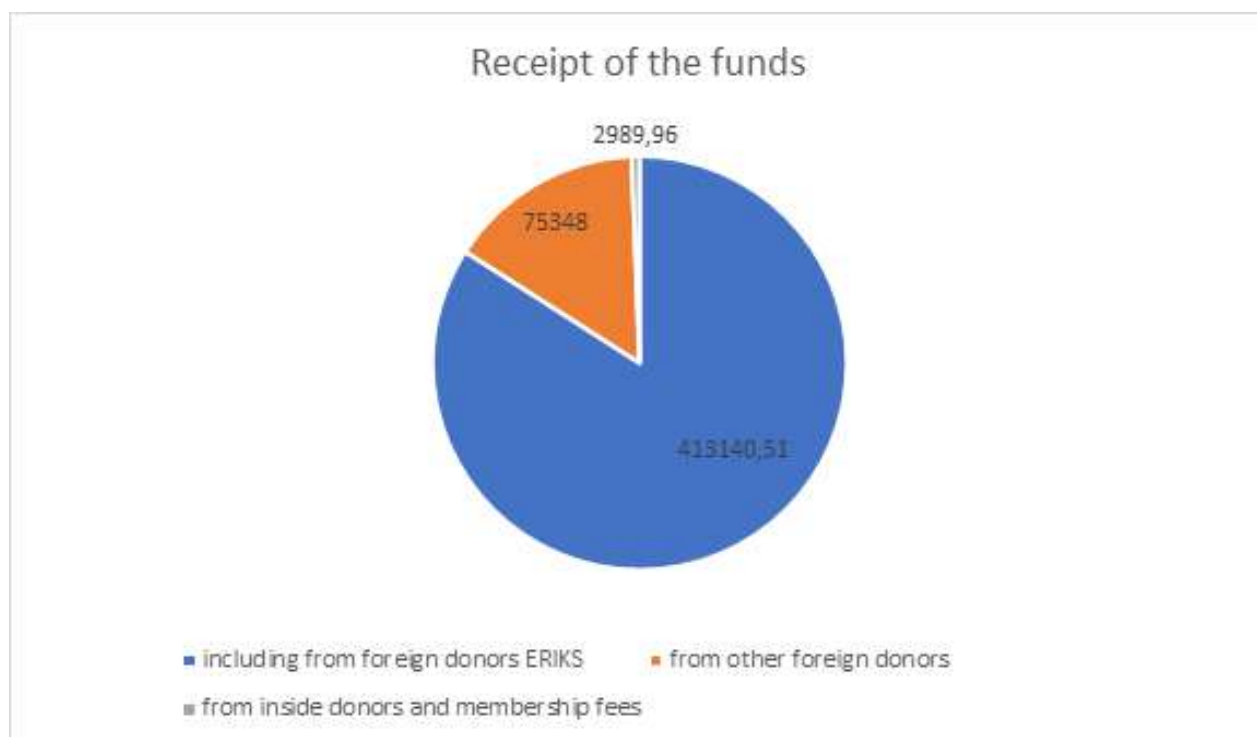

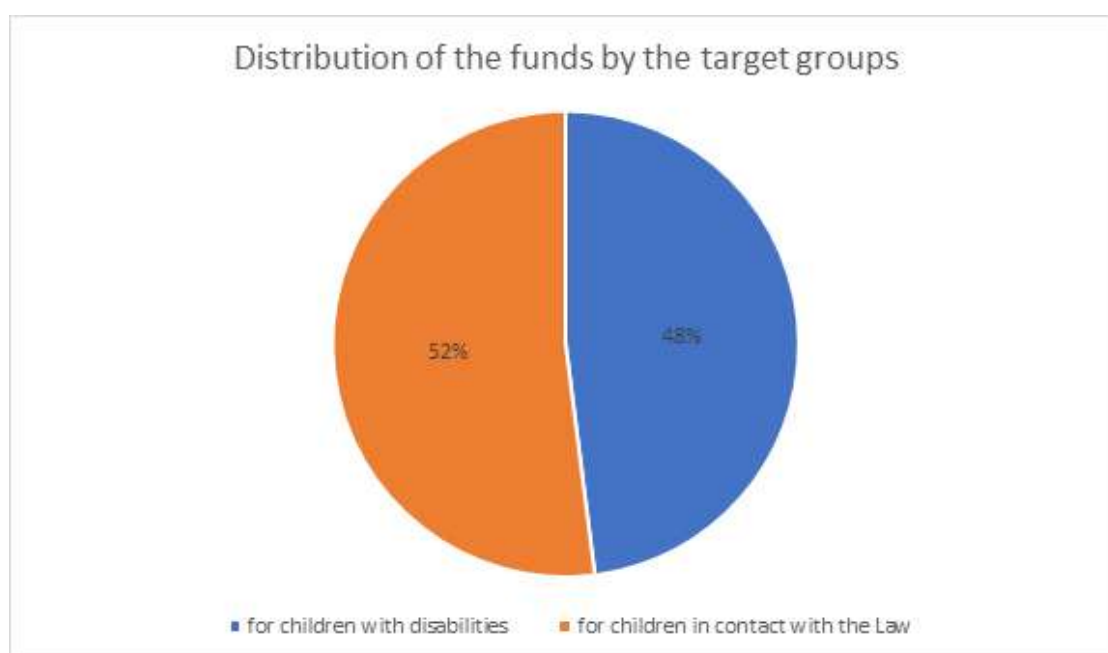
